To be considered for a banner, the nominee must meet the following requirements:

- 2. Served / is currently serving in one of the following branches: Army, Navy, Marines, Air Force, National Guard, Coast Guard or Reserves.
- 3. Meet one of the following criteria: Active Duty, reserves, or honorably discharged Veteran alive or deceased.

Banner Design, Time Frame & Location

Banners are 28" x 60", double sided, vinyl material and include person's name, branch of service, and photograph. Banners will be displayed on telephone poles in Lacona and Sandy Creek, from Memorial Day to Veterans Day, for 2 years.

Banner locations will be selected randomly.

We will contact you for a digital or emailed picture of the applicant in Uniform. Photo must be approved.

Banner Pricing & Donations

The banner cost is \$200.00 each, if you would like to put 2 people on one banner please add 25.00. Cost includes the production of the banner, installation, and removal. If the full amount is a hardship, please check the box on the application to "request consideration for sponsorship." Your request is not guaranteed. There are a limited number of banner locations available. Applications not processed for 2022 will be put on a waiting list for the 2023 Banner Program.
